Longevity Pay Increased Again:

10-14 years: \$625
15-19 years: \$1,250
20-24 years: \$2,500

2023-2024

We introduced a new tiered raise structure that rewards longevity and service!

Raises by Years of Employment:

• 0-1 years: **Placed at new starting range**

1–4 years: 3.5% increase
 5–9 years: 5% increase

10–14 years: 6.5% increase
15–19 years: 7.5% increase

Employees who have already exceeded the maximum of the new salary range received a 5% bonus.

Retroactive Pay Secured:

All raises were made retroactive to October 1, 2024—a major win for our members.

& Fighting for Full Board Authority:

When \$7.2 million was left on the table for months, SPALC pushed back and secured an additional \$1.4 million after declaring Impasse.

This **extra funding** strengthened our ability to address pay compression and ensure **retroactive pay**—priorities we pledged to fight for.

2024-2025

SPALC Members — Another Huge Win!

We're excited to share that we've secured another big victory for SPALC members!

Important Dates to Remember:

September 9 – You will receive your new pay calculation.

September 24 – Members will vote to ratify the contract.

October 7 – The School Board votes.

☑ If ratified and approved, your raise will be retroactive back to your first day of school this year!

This is a direct result of the power of standing together as union members. Stay tuned for more details, and be ready to make your voice heard on **September 24th!**


